About Us

Help Bristol's Homeless was founded in 2016 by Jasper Thompson, starting with a single caravan on Malago Road. Fast forward eight years, and we have grown into a £1m charity. Our Spring Street Project features 32 micro-flats, which have helped and supported over 500 individuals. We do not receive any government assistance and rely on corporate and public funding, as well as various events we organise throughout the year.

Each of our micro-flats is sponsored, and we offer a comprehensive Wellbeing Support Programme. This programme includes a range of services such as qualified counsellors, wellbeing consultants, assistant practitioners, dental services, massage therapists, career mentoring, career pathways, support workers, and DWP link workers.

We are currently in the process of acquiring a second location, in addition to the Spring Street Project, to support 22 additional homeless individuals. This expansion will increase our total capacity from 32 to 55 individuals this year.

SPONSOR A ROOM

We have a total of 22 bedrooms, which include a mix of single, double, and double ensuite rooms. Each sponsorship costs £1,500 and lasts for up to 2 years. Sponsoring a room will cover all costs for full furnishing, which includes, but is not limited to: a bed, bedding, wardrobe, bedside table, chest of drawers, mirror, TV, fridge, and cooking facilities. This sponsorship helps take an individual off the streets.

All of our sponsors receive recognition on both the package they support and across our social media platforms, making it a fantastic way to engage and demonstrate your support.

SPONSORING A CONTAINER CONVERSION

In addition to sponsoring a room, we also offer opportunities to sponsor the conversion of a shipping container into a micro-flat. Each sponsorship costs between £20,000 and £30,000 and lasts for the lifetime of the container. By sponsoring a micro-flat, you will cover all the expenses needed to convert an empty shipping container into a one-bedroom, single-occupancy flat.

Each unit will feature a bedroom with an ensuite bathroom, a fully fitted kitchen with cooking facilities, and a lounge area, helping to provide a home for someone in need and taking another individual off the streets.

We will place a sponsorship plaque on the exterior of the micro-flat displaying your name / corporate logo. Additionally, your details will be recognised as a sponsor on our social media platforms.

You also have the option to have your sponsored micro-flat wrapped in a choice of designs or company logo for an additional cost.
